- Selected posters will be displayed at Bay Day and/or at Century Bank branches around south Jersey.
- Entries will be divided into two age categories: Grades K - 4th and Grades 5th - 8th.
- First, second & third place prizes, sponsored by Port Norris Rotary, will be awarded in each age category.
- One overall Grand Prize winner will be chosen to have their poster on the cover of the 2011 Bay Day festival program book AND will receive a \$50.00 savings bond.
- Century Savings Bank will award an Education Sail for 45 students & chaperones to the school that they judge to have the "best all around" posters.
- Prizes will be awarded at the Delaware Bay Day festival on June 11<sup>th</sup>, 2011. Winners will be notified in advance.

**POSTER CONTEST RULES**

- Posters should depict your connection to the Bay—wildlife, water, people, places, history, activities and/or events.
- All posters should include the phrase "Bay Day 2011"
- Posters can be done as a class project but each should be individually created.
- Posters should be no larger than 11" X 17".
- Artwork may be in any media, but must be original, hand drawn or painted. NO tracings, stamps or computer-generated graphics.
- Entries must have complete contact information on back in order to be considered for a prize.
