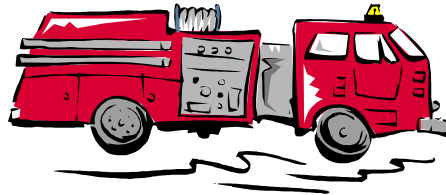
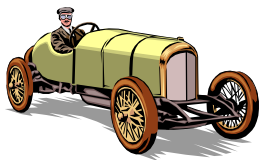


Delaware Bay Days ~ June 12th and 13th 2010
