- **The deadline for entries is May 10, 2009.** There is no entry fee!
- Open to published or unpublished poets age 16 and up.
- Poems must be no longer than 45 lines.
- No more than 3 entries per author.
- Include authors name, address & phone number (e-mail if available).

**Prizes will be awarded at Delaware Bay Days, hosted by Bayshore Discovery Project, on June 13<sup>th</sup>, 2009 in Bivalve, NJ.**

Winning poets will be invited to read on stage.
